Cancellation policy

If a prospective participant has to cancel his/her attendance but has already paid the registration fee, he/she will be reimbursed (except for bank charges) only if cancellation is made before 1st September, 2018.

Arrival/Departure Nice Airport

Sanremo is located in the Northern part of Italy, approximately 140 km West of Genoa (1 hour and 45minutes by car) and 60 km East of Nice, France, where the nearest airport is located (1 hour by car).

Group transport from and to Nice airport will be provided, according to the needs of participants, on the days of the event. A contribution of 50 Euro (return trip) will be charged for this service.

On Wednesday 5th September, the Institute’s personnel will be waiting for participants arriving at Nice airport near the information desk at Terminal 1 (in front of the exit from baggage claim and custom control).

Certificate of attendance

A certificate of attendance will be issued on request (please ask the Secretariat when registering).

Passport and Visa

Participants from countries needing a visa are advised to ask for a several-entries Schengen visa before departure (application must be presented at least one month before the event). Sometimes, visas are also requested for transit countries (UK, USA and others). Visas are not issued at Nice airport.

Insurance – Travel and Health

Participants will be responsible for their adequate travel and health insurance. Under no circumstances can the Institute be held responsible for medical expenses incurred by participants during their stay in Sanremo.

Accommodation

Accommodation, meals and all other costs which are not covered by the registration fee will be the participants’ responsibility.
