### Call for Expression of Interest – Graphic Designer

#### Purpose

The Department of International Refugee Law and Migration Law (hereafter “the department”) of the International Institute of Humanitarian Law (Sanremo, Italy) is pleased to present the **Call for Expression of Interest** to private individuals and companies with expertise in graphic design of annual reports, learning material and social media communication.

The overarching objective of the Call for Expression of Interest is to develop graphic design of the annual report of activities of the Department, the related Public Information documentation (e.g. executive summaries, highlights, figures at a glance etc.) as well as the graphic design of learning material on International Refugee Law, Human Rights Law and other legal frameworks.

#### Background information

The International Institute of Humanitarian Law is an independent, non-profit, humanitarian organization, founded in 1970. The Institute’s primary activities are the delivery of regular and ad hoc courses on Humanitarian Law, Human Rights, Refugee Law, and related fields of law; the dissemination of materials and research relevant to the above mentioned areas of law; the exchange of expertise and best practices among lecturers and participants of the workshops. The Institute has earned a solid reputation grounded on independence, academic rigor, and creative learning methodologies.

The Department develops and implements courses on International Refugee Law, Internal Displacement, Statelessness and Migration. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Department has moved its training online using a customized online learning platform that hosts virtual classes, an online resource library and several interactivity features. In 2020, eleven online courses were implemented with an average evaluation rating by participants of 9.16 out of 10 on the quality of the courses. The courses are designed for mid and senior-level government officials, members of civil society and academia. The aim is to enhance their knowledge and skills concerning legal and other safeguards related to the protection of refugees, internally displaced persons, stateless people, and migrants.
