The International Institute of Humanitarian Law has been offering general courses on International Refugee Law since 1982. These courses, are now available in English, French, and Arabic. They are organized in close cooperation with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), and with the support of the Swiss State Secretariat for Migration and the US State Department (Bureau of Population, Refugees and Migration).

The International Refugee Law Courses have been developed primarily to train government officials who are involved in the formulation and application of law and policy for the benefit of refugees, returnees, internally displaced persons and other persons in need of protection. Over the years, the courses have increasingly welcomed members of civil society organisations, scholars and researchers, humanitarian workers and others engaged in advocacy and protection work at all levels.

During the five-day course in Sanremo, participants have a unique opportunity to interact not only with each other, but also with recognised experts who facilitate the various thematic sessions of the programme. Different participatory methodologies are used in order to maximize learning. Real-time evaluation prepares participants to apply their newly acquired knowledge and skills in their professional practice.
