OUTLINE INFORMATION

The International Institute of Humanitarian Law and the International Committee of the Red Cross are pleased to invite you to join the 45th Sanremo Round Table on: "After the Conflict before the Peace: Legal Military and Humanitarian Issues during the Transition".

The Round Table, with the participation of high-level international experts and practitioners, will investigate some of the crucial issues regarding the application of IHL in post-conflict situations, by examining the lessons learned from recent operations, as well as the legal, military and humanitarian issues experienced in post-conflict transitions with a focus on Non-combatant Evacuation Operations (NEOs).

The Round Table will be held in a hybrid format, with sessions allowing for remote participation broadcasted live from Villa Ormond, Sanremo (Italy).

Attendance

The 45th Sanremo Round Table on Current Issues of IHL will be held on-site at Villa Ormond, Sanremo (Italy), and fully broadcasted live allowing remote attendance.

The link to the online broadcasting of the conference will be shared with registered participants a few days before the opening of the event.

During the conference, a simultaneous translation service English-French and French-English will be provided online. For this reason, attendees will be required to access the online broadcasting to take advantage of the interpretation service. The Institute will provide the on-site participants with disposable wired headphones on request. To use devices that are not compatible with wired headphones, participants are invited to join already equipped with own wireless headphones.

A Wi-Fi connection service will be made available on the Conference premises by the Institute free of charge.

The Round Table will be conducted in English with translation from/to English in French.

Certificate of attendance

Passport and Visa

Participants from countries needing a visa are advised to ask for a Schengen visa before departure (application must be presented at least one month before the event). Sometimes, visas are also requested for transit countries (UK, USA and others). **Visas are not issued at Nice airport.**

Participants will be responsible for their adequate travel and health insurance. Under no circumstances the Institute can be held responsible for medical expenses incurred by participants during their stay in Sanremo.

Accommodation
