In the overall framework of the conference, the International Institute of Humanitarian Law and the International Committee of the Red Cross are pleased to call for the submission of short essays that address or explore specific aspects of the following broad topics:

Navigating contemporary maritime warfare: respecting International Humanitarian Law amidst new technologies and old (?) rules

Upholding IHL in modern non-international armed conflicts: challenges and opportunities

Internment, Security Detention, and POWs' treatment: addressing IHL challenges in contemporary armed conflicts

Protecting Civilians and the most vulnerable in occupied territories

In order to be eligible for consideration by the organisers, essays must be:

- Written by one person, in English or French, and **no longer than 2500 words** (including footnotes);
- Submitted by a person who is either between 18 and 35 years old, or is enrolled in a PhD programme, provided that the person is no more than 38 years old;
- Submitted by a person who is **not a staff member of the IIHL or of the ICRC** (interns/associates are eligible);
- Received by the organizers by **16 August 2024** (midnight, Rome time).
