# **Background**

Disasters are among the largest threats to human security and development the world is facing today. Is international law stepping up? Are humanitarian actors, institutions and scholars ready to face challenges raised by disasters caused by natural hazards or human activities?

This hybrid specialised course will provide a comprehensive overview of the existing international provisions and key regulatory issues related to the prevention and management of disasters, including through a residential specialized workshop focusing on the challenges they pose and how they are addressed in the EU context.

# **Target audience**

Staff of governments, international and regional organizations, NGOs, National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, academics, graduate and post-graduate students with an interest in humanitarian assistance and disaster management issues.

# Structure

Through a mixture of online and on-site lectures, practical exercises, self-assessment tools and interactive group works, the course, organised by the Sanremo Institute in collaboration with the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) Disaster Law and with the support of the Italian Red Cross, will provide a dynamic and tailored learning environment to all participants.

# Online course

The online section of the course will feature both live and self-paced sessions, including learning opportunities of different kinds.

The online part of the training will particularly address topics including the basics of international and regional disaster law, the interplay between Disaster Law, International Humanitarian Law, Human Rights Law and Refugee Law, the overall legal framework of Disaster Risk Prevention and Preparedeness, and an introduction to Disaster Response and Management.
