Background

Disasters are among the largest threats to human security and development the world is facing today. Is international law stepping up? Are humanitarian actors, institutions and scholars ready to face challenges raised by disasters caused by natural hazards or human activities?

This hybrid specialised course will provide a comprehensive overview of the existing international provisions and key regulatory issues related the to prevention and management of disasters, including through a residential specialized workshop focusing on the challenges they pose and how they are addressed in the EU context.

Staff of governments, international and regional organizations, NGOs, National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, academics, graduate and post-graduate students with an interest in humanitarian assistance and disaster management issues.

Online course
